Fleetwood's Unger named top prospect

Fleetwood junior Corey Unger recently was named the top quarterback prospect at the SVS

Elite 25 East Coast Showcase Camp, held at the University of Maryland.

The camp, directed by former Wilson coach Jim Cantafio, had the top 25 quarterbacks from SVS camps throughout the year.

Unger edged junior Adam Saad of Penn Manor to win the 11th/12th grade division.

Among the competitors were Virginia recruit Matt Johns of Central Bucks South and NC State recruit Manny Stocker of Coatesville.

Hunter Reeser of Gov. Mifflin was a semifinalist for the seventh/eighth grade division of the Elite 25 camp.

As a sophomore last season, Unger set school passing records for yards in a

season (1,815) and game (289); he is the Tigers career passing leader, with 2,662 yards.
